### We Are Investing in Your Future!

MCCU has experienced tremendous growth since we built in 2003. Assets have tripled; loans have doubled; countless products and services have been added in the last 13 years to serve our growing membership all at no cost to you. We are fortunate to have the opportunity for new business through the young new hires in the plant who desire our financial services and will grow up in the credit union family. We have over 600 youth as members of the credit union.

We no longer have any space to add additional employees to provide adequate services to our members (all empty corners of the building have been absorbed). The board and staff are pleased to announce a decision to proceed with an expansion and remodel project. The board has set a budget they are comfortable with. As we did in 2003, there will not be a mortgage for this project. Not only are we building space for our current needs but taking into consideration potential growth for the next 10-15 years by including raw space for future offices.

We plan to begin construction in May and have the project complete by early 2017. We have contracted with a local firm, Prairie Landworks and architect, Chad Glenn, with 3Ten Studios.

You may have noticed this past week that we've relocated our trees to outer boundaries of the property in preparation for the project. In April you will see us working on the drive-thru canopy. During construction, we will be moving our drive-thru services to the NE corner of the credit union separating the ATM service from drive-thru service.

On May 16, you'll see a double-wide unit moved onto our south lot which will become our temporary home keeping staff and members safe during the expansion and remodel project.

We will close on Friday, May 20 and Monday, May 23 to move into our lovely, temporary home and will re-open on Tuesday morning. We hope you enjoy watching the progress and that you are patient with us during the project by accepting a little more dust in our workspace, and a little more casual dress code.

We promise that the staff's infectious smiles and positive attitudes will not go away. We are reliable, approachable, dedicated and passionate. Helping our members thrive now and in the future is our top priority
